**White lines** Most people would like to see greenhouse gases reduced (it's estimated that within 45 years, atmospheric levels of carbon could rise from the current 395 parts per million to 750ppm), but visualizing the problem can be difficult. Here to help: designer Jussara Lee, green organization the Canary Project and their joint installation, **Albedo Clouds on East River, City Sol!**. Set to dangle over the East River at 23rd Street as part of the clean-energy-powered arts and music festival, Citysol (Jul 12-15; visit [citysol.org](http://citysol.org) for more info), the piece consists of 550 recycled dress shirts, representing the European Union's proposed limit of 550ppm for all greenhouse gases by 2050. Let's hope we can collar global warming before it's too late. —*Daniel Derouche*
